

THINGS YOU NEED TO BRING

Any gaming material you require to play, including:

- Your models
- Two copies of your Army/Team Roster
- This rules pack and your tournament pack
- Rulebooks, supplemental texts, and Reference sheets including official errata:
- Games Workshop > Gaming > Errata and FAQ
- Privateer Press > Community
- Pen, paper, dice, templates, and tape measure.
- Superglue (the 'table-top battlefield medic')

THINGS YOU NEED TO SORT OUT FOR YOURSELF

- · Some spending money.
- · Transport to and from the event.

BREAKS, LUNCH AND REFRESHMENTS

A lunch break is scheduled in to your tournament. During this break we recommend that you eat and refresh yourself. Either bring food, or avail yourself of the multiple vendors on South Bridge, Nicholson Street, George IV Bridge and so on. There is a bar on site for drinks.

HOW OUR TOURNAMENT WORKS

Participants play in a number of games over the day. This will be either three of four depending on the system.

The scenario for each game is listed in the appropriate section. After each game the results are recorded and help to determine your opponent for the following round using a Swiss system.

If you find yourself facing the same opponent a second time, please notify an Organiser who'll sort you out with a new opponent. After all, we'd rather see you mixing with as many faces as possible.

The winner of each tournament will be the player with the highest total score. Any ties will be decided as detailed in the tournament pack.

We will endeavour to supply a 'stand-in' player to keep the number of players even. Should this not be possible, or should a player miss a game through no fault of their own, then they will be awarded a 'bye'.

WHERE ARE WE?

Adam House is on Chambers Street in Edinburgh (postcode: EH1 1HR). The venue is a 10- minute walk from Waverley train station, or 15-minutes from St Andrew's Square bus station.
